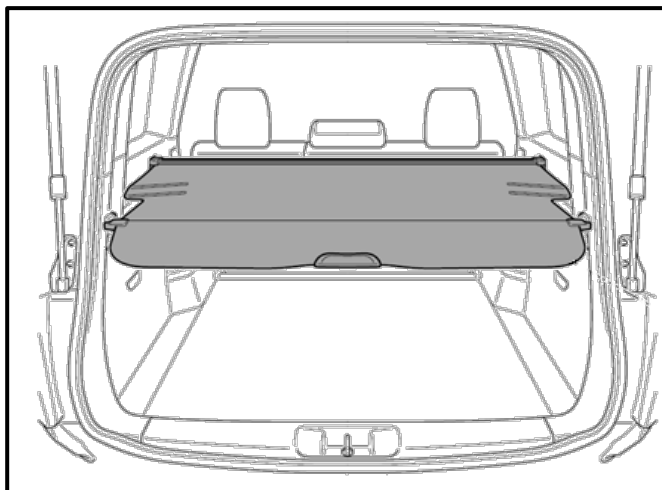
REVISION MARK: This mark highlights a change in installation with respect to previous issue.

REGULATORY MARK: This mark indicates the component is related to regulatory compliance



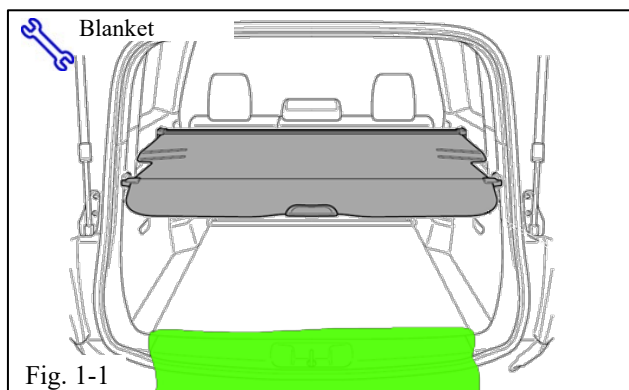
Care must be taken when installing this accessory to ensure damage does not occur to the vehicle. The installation of this accessory should follow approved guidelines to ensure a quality installation.

These guidelines can be found in the "Accessory Installation Practices" document.

This document covers such items as:-

- Vehicle Protection (use of covers and blankets, cleaning chemicals, etc.).
- Safety (eye protection, rechecking torque procedure, etc.).
- Vehicle Disassembly/Reassembly (panel removal, part storage, etc.).
- Electrical Component Disassembly/Reassembly (battery disconnection, connector removal, etc.).

1. Prepare the Vehicle

STOP (a) Protect the rear bumper with a protective blanket/fabric for installation of the cargo cover (Fig. 1-1).

(b) Fold Down Rear Seats.

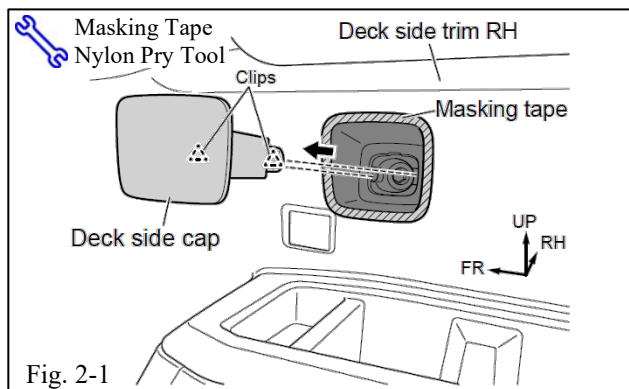
2. Deck Side Cap Removal

(a) Place masking tape along the deck side cap/trim edge.

! (b) Using a Nylon Pry tool, pry along the edge and remove the RH deck side cap from RH deck side trim (Fig. 2-1).

(c) Repeat steps 2 (a) and 2(b) for the LH side.

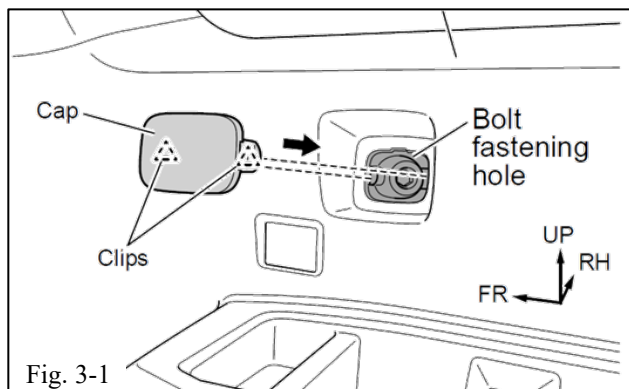
(d) Remove masking tape.

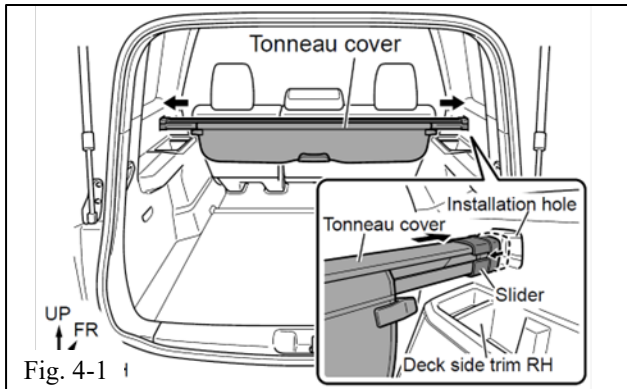


3. Cap Installation

(a) Fit the cap into the bolt fastening hole on RH deck side trim (Fig 3-1).

(b) Repeat step 3(a) for the LH side.

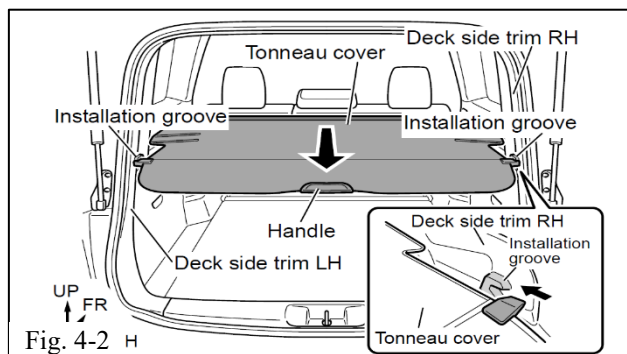




4. Tonneau Cover Installation

- (a) Compress the slider on one side of the tonneau cover and insert it into the RH deck side trim (Fig. 4-1).
- (b) Repeat step 4(a) for the LH side.

⚠ Note: Ensure that the tonneau cover is firmly secured



- (d) Pull the tonneau cover handle and fit both ends into the RH/LH deck side trim installation grooves to secure (Fig. 4-2).

⚠ Note: Ensure that the tonneau cover has been firmly secured in the installation grooves
